<u>China</u> <u>Peking University</u> <u>Guanghua School of Management Program</u>

The Guanghua School of Management (GSM) is one of many schools and departments of the prestigious Peking University (PKU). Established in December 1993 by merging the Department of Economics and Management, the School of Economics, and the Center of Management Science, Guanghua was originally called the Peking University Business School. The name was changed in 1994 to honor a donation from the Guanghua Education Foundation in Hong Kong. Located in Beijing, China, GSM not only gives students the opportunity to obtain firsthand experience with business in Asia but also to explore the modern political, cultural, and educational center of China and many important ancient sites.

GSM has extensive collaboration and exchange programs with leading international institutions. These partnerships are essential to the continuous growth of scholarships at the school and have made important contributions to the international academic community. The international student body, representing 30 countries and the large number of professors who have earned their PhDs at overseas universities contribute to the international perspective in the classroom with a focus on China. Peking University is ranked #39 in the 2023 US News Best Global Universities rankings.

FACILITIES/HOUSING

On-campus accommodation is currently NOT officially arranged by PKU due to overwhelming demand. Exchange students need to arrange their own outside accommodation. Guanghua International Students Association (GISA) and the Office of International Relations offer necessary information regarding accommodation.

Range of off-campus housing rates: US\$450 – 650 for one single room in a two-bedroom / three-bedroom apartment per month.
