After over 30 years' unremitting efforts, ACEM has established itself as a modern business school with a solid reputation at home and abroad. It is the first business school in mainland China to have been triply accredited by AACSB, EQUIS, and AMBA, the three largest and most influential business school accreditation associations in the world.

ACEM's vision is to transform the college into a leader among the nation's business schools and a premier business education provider in Asia and to build a world-class reputation for excellence. As a business school rooted in China, Antai strives to promote social progress through creating innovative knowledge in economics and management sciences and cultivating ethical leaders with global vision. ACEM plays an important role in global higher education organizations to promote multilateral cooperation and organizes many academic and cultural activities abroad to deepen mutual understanding between people from different countries and regions.

### **FACILITIES/HOUSING**

Antai College of Economics and Management (ACEM) is located at 1954 Huashan Road, the historic Xuhui campus of Shanghai Jiao Tong University. The college's main building is the Pao Sui-Loong Library Building, while the administration and faculty offices are in the New Administration Building. Laboratories and other research centers are in Zhongyuan, the oldest building on campus, completed in 1899. Classrooms and student halls are housed in Xinshangyuan and the No. 1 Graduate Building, respectively. There are 2 dormitory buildings for international students on the Xuhui Campus:

### 1. Lianxing Building:

A six-story building with unified standard single rooms. Each room is furnished with a single bed, closet, desk, chair, TV, telephone, air-conditioner, internet access, and a private bathroom; there is a laundry room (fully equipped) on the first floor; all floors have a public kitchen only open to dormitory residents.

#### 2. Asian Youth Center (Tao Li Yuan):

A four-story building with both single and double rooms. Each room is furnished with single beds, a closet, desk, chair, TV, telephone, air conditioning, internet access, microwave oven, water dispenser, and a refrigerator. Each floor has a public bathroom.
