## **INTRO**

The IPADE Business School is one of the five schools in the Pan-American University, Mexico. It offers a full-time MBA (MEDE), Executive MBA (MEDEX), and several other special programs. All these programs are based on the teaching methodology of case analysis, boast an extensive local and international executive network, and aim to ultimately form successful entrepreneurial leaders in the global context.

With its emphasis in the international business environment, IPADE partners with over 40 renowned institutions from around the globe to form a dynamic student exchange program. The school is accredited by AACSB International.

IPADE's Exchange Program is designed to give participants the opportunity to live abroad while developing global administrative skills, such as leadership and management.

## **FACILITIES/HOUSING**

Located in Mexico City, a city rich in both culture and economic potential, the central campus stands in the former Hacienda de San Antonio Claveria, a colonial monument from the 17th century. This historical structure provides students with a pleasant atmosphere for studying and interacting. IPADE Business School has case room style classrooms, library, computer center, and cafeteria. There is no on-campus housing, but the school provides some assistance for international exchange students in finding rooms at local hotels. You can also choose to find your own accommodation. Accommodation costs around US\$400 - \$1,000.
