## What does the program fee cover?

#### On-Site

- Accommodations double occupancy\* at the designated hotel in the program destination cities and during the program dates
- Flight between Seoul and Hong Kong
- Program related ground transportation with local guide M-F during program dates
- Mandatory welcome dinner on-site
- Breakfast daily at hotel, and lunch M-F during program dates
- Program development fee for in-country partners
- Other program-related costs such as: Gifts for hosts, venue rentals, translation services

- The assurance of 24-hour service and emergency availability

- Transportation from the airport to the hotel in Seoul on the arrival day and from the hotel to the airport in Hong Kong at the end of the program Any deviations from the group itinerary or travel extensions
- Any items that are not listed under the items covering by the program fee

### How can I select a roommate?

- We will ask you to access your GPP Profile and review the list of students assigned to the same GSBA 582 section and traveling to the same destination. From that list, you can select a roommate, and the system will automatically send them an email request. Roommate requested must be accepted by both individuals for the system to assign as roommates.
- You can also select "assign a roommate" in your GPP Profile. We will then pair you with a same sex roommate.
- If you do not select a roommate during the allotted time, we will randomly select a same sex roommate for you.

# Can I request a single room?

- In your GPP Profile, You can select "I intend to pay for a single room."
- If you choose to request a single room, there will be an additional cost to cover the accommodation for the program dates only.
- Single rooms are subject to availability and rates vary depending on the room type available.
- You will need to pay the travel agency Crown International Travel directly before the deadline, otherwise you will be assigned a roommate.
